Event Description: The event will preview a new report by the Institute for Research and Evaluation (IRE) on the results of school-based comprehensive sexuality education. This new international analysis of existing research on CSE effectiveness shows that globally, school-based CSE programs failed to show effectiveness 87% of the time (89% in Africa) and that some CSE programs even increased risk behaviors.
